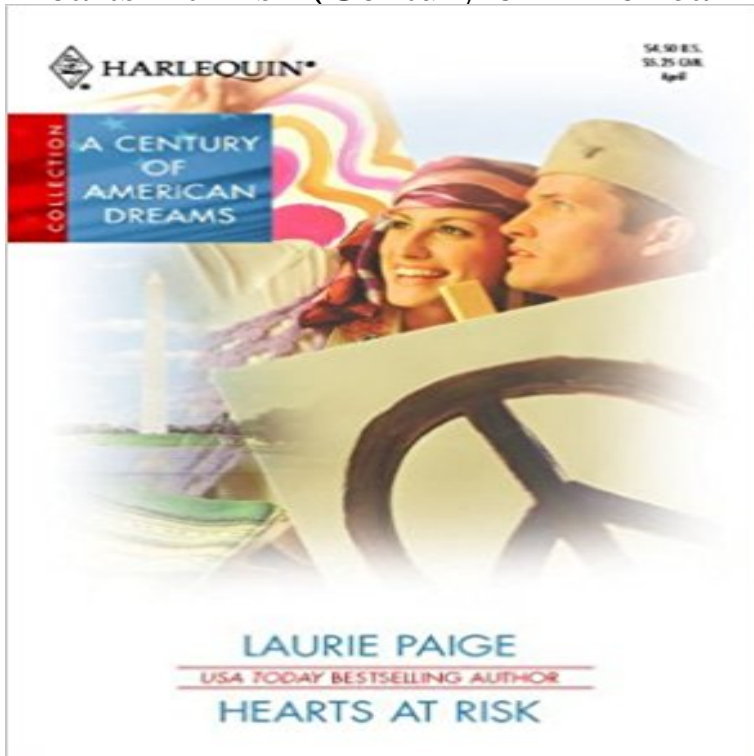


Hearts At Risk (Century of American Dreams)
